Additionally, he was Managing Director of mergers and acquisitions for Endeavour Financial, a director of Ventana Gold until its takeover by AUX Canada Acquisition in 2011, and a director of Plutonic Power until its merger with Magma Energy in 2011. At the time of his passing, he was Chairman of K92 Mining and Sun Summit Minerals, and a valued member of Thunderstruck's Advisory Board.
